- \*Recognizing and encouraging individual talents among children.
- \*Improving nutritional aspects for the children.
- \*Providing quality education to children and striving for holistic development.

## Facilities being provided for educational advancement. :-



- 1. Construction of two new buildings at GLPS Hosuru School.

Gramothan Foundation has undertaken the construction of two classrooms spanning 1500 sqft in Nerulur village, Chandapura, Anekal taluk. This initiative is part of our CSR program aimed at providing education support, located near our factory.











From our Gramothan Foundation's initiative, the Gram Panchayat of D B Kuppe has given increased priority to rural development, serving as a catalyst for holistic community growth. Through various programs in the region, our organization is actively involved in enhancing the quality of life for people and executing projects aimed at uplifting their standard of living



#### **Health-Related Facilities:-**

- Every month, health check-ups and free treatment are provided by conducting medical examinations for 13 villages and 7 hamlets.
- Conducting health check-ups and providing free treatment by organizing Old Age Camps and Village Camps, going door-to-door for medical examinations
- Providing free diabetes (sugar) and blood pressure (BP) camps.
- Providing treatment for patients suffering from terminal illnesses.
- Conducting health awareness programs in villages and settlements.
- Providing free treatment for senior citizens and single parents.
- Prioritizing Ayurveda and enhancing health by providing Ayurvedic treatment to patients, aiming to improve their well-being.
- During camps conducted in schools, villages, and settlements, providing surgical treatment to patients requiring surgical intervention.
- Sending mentally ill patients for free treatment to city hospitals every month.
- Sending senior citizens for advanced treatment to city hospitals.





On behalf of our Gramothan Foundation, D B Kuppe Gram Panchayat has given high priority to rural and has led to the all-round development of the people. Here, our organization works towards improving the living standards of the people by implementing many projects to improve the living standards of the people.

#### **Purpose**

Our institution aims to provide free healthcare to the people in this region as these are remote villages where it's not feasible for residents to travel 40 to 50 kilometers for medical treatment. Therefore, our institution is committed to offering healthcare services at no cost, with the purpose of improving the health of the people in this area.



### Facilities provided for rural development:-

From our organization, several benefits are being provided for rural development, some of which include

- Providing further education for students who have completed SSLC and PUC.
- Implementing water projects in areas essential within the village.
- Offering skill development training for self-employment, constructing toilets, and providing training for tailoring. Providing goats to self-help group members.
- Taking complete responsibility for the care of 15 elderly individuals, including providing food grains, housing, healthcare, and transportation.
- Assisting 36 single parents by providing essential amenities and ensuring the education and health of their children.
- Establishing cooperative banks specifically for women's groups, providing loans at lower interest rates, ensuring the financial stability of women."



- Conducting surveys to identify individuals in need of rehabilitation.
- Providing cows to single parents.
- Facilitating government-provided amenities through the assistance center: Aadhaar cards, ration cards, caste and income certificates, widow pensions, old age pensions, mental health schemes, etc.
- Formation of new associations.



Our institution had established cooperative banks within the D.B. Kuppe Gram Panchayat area to improve the standard of living for the people. Operations were ongoing, but when the COVID-19 pandemic hit, there was a setback. However, this year, efforts are being made to revitalize the banks by forming women's self-help groups, empowering women, and ensuring their economic stability.

- Currently, Rs. 2,00,000 out of the Rs. 5,00,000 loan has been recovered.
- Currently, Rs. 6,00,000 has been provided to women's self-help groups, along with individual loans with Rs. 4,20,000.
- A new total loan of Rs.11,20,000 has been disbursed, with Rs. 2,94,000 principal and Rs. 42,000 interest has been collected.

Our cooperative bank conducts skill development training alongside loan facilities for women, working diligently towards the development and progress of women by providing them with these opportunities.
