Corporate Social Responsibility Of Maini Group

Program Reports FY 2021 to 2022







Due to the Covid-19 pandemic situations across the country, few of our ongoing CSR Projects were slowed down for the sake of social distancing particularly Schools.

Hence the year 2020 – 2021 /22 did not have much activities. We are optimistic to develop the projects that were put on hold and address the immediate needs of the villagers.





Education Initiatives



BUILDING A BETTER TOMORROW



Schools have resumed after two years of Covid. Gramothan has undertaken repairs and maintenance of Schools, toilets, Electrification, water and teachers for five schools and resumed Yoga classes.









Proposed for the next Academic year



- We have adopted 6 schools in the HD Kote village. Planning to adopt few more Anganwadis (Crèche)
- The existing 8 Anganwadis are in a hut and very bad shape. We are planning to renovate / construct it.
- Anganwadis will have about 15 to 20 kids (below 5 year) Anganwadis requires a kitchen, a hall and a play area.





Health Initiatives



Health



- 6F Clinics provide treatments both in Ayurveda & Allopathy.
- Majority of the tribals prefer home medicines. GF has initiated Health camps in 15 villages twice a month and provide free medicines. The tribals have now started visiting our clinics in small numbers.









Treatment for Mentally retarded: There are many who are neglected in their houses. GF helped for their treatment at Chittadama hospital in HD Kote and there is good progress in the patients' health.





Health Camps



- During Pandemic, all the Health camps were put on hold and were only concentrating on Covid related illness and providing Ayurvedic medicines for the Covid patients.
- Out of six thousand population in 23 villages, approx. sixty people were treated for Covid by our clinic and only two succumbed to covid.









Rural Development



Training in Tailoring



- Completed 8 batches Tailoring training for ladies and certificates were issued.
- Sponsored High speed USHA brand machine with 50% GF contribution.
- Training for 120 girls completed out which 30% females have started working from home and earning about Rs. 8,000 per month.







NABARD Loan facilities



 NABARD - a Central Govt. scheme provides loan of Rs. 40,000 for the Villagers livelihood – for Agriculture, poultry, Diary, petty shops.

GF facilitated the requirements and totally 90 people have been benefited

through this scheme.







Physically challenged



• GF in association with the Forest dept. provided physically challenged equipments like walker, shoes, wheel chair etc.







Drinking water & street Light



 Provided drinking water lines for 100 houses at Kadagadde village by connecting the borewell / panchayati water. Villages have purchased the tank and GF supported by laying the pipelines and the stand for the tank.







Solar Street Lights for the tribals and villages



On the request of the villagers and frequent animal attack, GF provided Solar Street lights for Four tribal villages and kadagadde village. This program will continue in other villages







Home for Old age orphans

- GF continued to adopt 17 old aged people.
- During the year three people have died and adopted four more.
- Provided water, electricity, and toilet facilities for Six old age homes
- Goats were provided for old aged people for their livelihood.

Support for Women Counseling centre & Skill development



- GF continued its support to 'Parihar' (An NGO initiative by the Bengaluru City Police) for the development of Women, children & family Counseling Centre for the next two years.
- Parihar helps the distressed women through effective counseling and skill development and make them financially independent.















At the request of Parihar for women skill Development, GF supported with Teachers Salary and sponsored Two sewing machines for destitute women.




Support for Youth Sports

Now, the girl is playing for karnataka under -19. GF will support this girl for one more year. The boys are still playing for the clubs and not much progress.

Proposed projects for 2022-23:

- From the financial year 2022-23 we will announce scholarships in the name of SK Maini who wants to continue for higher studies after 12th Standard on a merit basis.
- Poor students who have passed NEET Exam, GF can support 2 girls /1 boy students with scholarship for their medical education in the name of Dr. SK Maini.
- Maini Group has companies in and around Anekal Taluk, Peenya & Nelamangala. There is a request from the Local Panchayat to support their schools in renovating and build 4 or 5 classrooms due to increase in the strength of the students as many have left private schools and joined Govt. schools due to Covid. As a part of CSR requirement to support within the locality, we are working on this project.



Proposed:

- -After successful completion of drinking water project for the Kadagadde village consisting of 100 houses, during this year, we want to provide drinking water pipeline by adopting two more villages (One tribal & one non-tribal) where 50 to 100 houses are there. Villagers will contribute 20% towards installation of water tanks.
- Discussing for installing cost effective solar lights for a cluster of 50 houses.
- Ongoing Projects:
- Training programs for organic farming, tailoring, driving etc.
- Govt. support programs like housing, pension schemes etc.
- Continue to support single parent (women and their children) whose husband has died due to animal attack for health & education.
- GF would like to support health and education for children, women skill development and old age home, outside the HD Kote Village. Either in and around Bangalore or other rural areas on a case to case basis
- Skill development for women and unemployed youth
